Now that the Nominating Committee has submitted its report, the process moves on through the petition process. Call the office at 352-383-8801 to request a petition. The petition must be signed by at least five members of the Chamber and filed with the nominating committee no later than October 3. Any Chamber staff member will be happy to assist you with completion of a petition nomination. If there is someone *you* would like to nominate, you may submit a nomination.

Any member in good standing may be nominated to the Board of Directors; however, no director shall be nominated to serve more than two consecutive terms until one (1) year has lapsed after his/her regularly elected term has expired. This restriction does not apply to appointed Directors.

If no petition is filed within the designated period, nominations shall be closed. A ballot will be prepared and mailed to membership with instructions for its completion and return. Ballots will be counted in accordance with the bylaws and results of the election shall be reported in writing to the Board of Directors.

Following the election of Directors, Bob Garrison, Lise Pelchat and Catherine Hanson shall act as the nominating committee for officers, who shall be selected from the incoming Board of Directors. At the November Board of Directors meeting, a slate of candidates for the following officers shall be submitted to the Board: President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. A candidate for President must have served on the Board of Directors for at least one year. Other officers may be selected from any of the incoming directors.

**Nominees will be formally introduced to Chamber members at our October Business After Hours, October 9, 5:30—7:00 pm, at Superior Storage, 24811 SR 46 in Sorrento. This is your opportunity to learn more about the candidates and how they believe their service will benefit the area and the Chamber.**

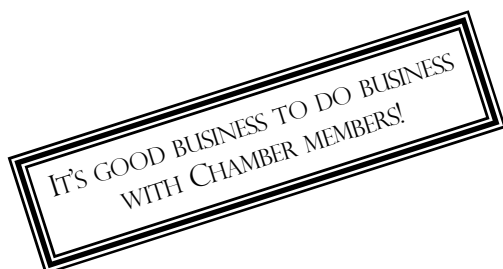
